	brush, medium pile roller or spray. For airless spray, dilution should not be required. For

CLEANING	Return surplus material to container. Wash tools & equipment with clean water or a
	warm soapy solution & rinse immediately after use.
STORAGE	Store upright and secure. Store in secure dry conditions inaccessible to children or

	above 40°C.
